

ORDINANCE I

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND MOTOR CYCLES WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS AND AMENDING THAT PORTION OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 1, THAT HERETOFORE SET SPEED LIMITS FOR SUCH VEHICLES WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF ELYSIAN.

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ELYSIAN ORDAINS:

1. That the definitions of motor vehicle and motorcycle shall be governed by the provision of Chapter 169 of Minnesota Statutes of 1964, as amended, known as the Highway Traffic Regulation Act.

2. That the provision of Ordinance Number 1, which ordinance adopted Chapter 169 of the Minnesota Statutes of 1964 as amended by laws of 1965, known as the Highway Traffic Regulation Act, is hereby amended to provide that the speed limit for motor vehicles and motorcycles within the village limits of the village of Elysian is twenty (20) miles per hour.

3. All other provisions of the said Ordinance Number 1 shall remain in full force and effect.

4. Penalty. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than (90) days, plus costs of prosecution in either case.

5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
