AN ORDINANCE SPECIFYING REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF THE CITY PARK

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYSIAN DOES ORDAIN:


SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to:

1. Utilize, or be on or about, the facilities, grounds, appurtenant structures, buildings, or any other such items located on or about, any city park, or real estate associated to or with the same, for any purpose whatsoever including, but not necessarily limited to the following: The parking of automobiles between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m.
2. No person or persons shall drive on grass on any/all parks, beach area, or ball field.
3. No animals are permitted in any part of all parks. Leashed animals are allowed in the parking lot area and may be allowed to swim/exercise in the area at the north end of the parking area. Pet owners are responsible for the behavior of their pets and for cleaning up and removing items associated with their pet.
4. Glass bottle containers of any type are prohibited in the park area, facilities, grounds, appurtenant structures, buildings, or any other such items located on or about, any city park, or real estate associated to or with the same.
5. No keg beer is allowed on the beach area; keg beer is allowed in the park picnic area and at the ball field, however, a keg permit is required which shall be applied for and a nominal fee paid at City Hall prior to the event. For the purposes of identification, the beach area is herein identified as the sanded area, and the picnic area is the shelter and grass area.

SECTION 2. PENALTY. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, with said conduct being punishable by imprisonment for up to 90 days and the imposition of a fine of up to \$1,000 or both.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law. All other preceding park ordinances become null and void.
