This letter is being sent to inform you of construction activity on the above-referenced project.

The contractor has completed the water main replacement on Lake Avenue and is continuing on 4th Street between Lake Avenue and Frank Avenue. Once the water main construction is complete, the contractor will begin installing individual water service lines first along Lake Avenue. When new water services are installed, they are constructed from the main line in the street to the right-of-way (property line). **Residents at these properties should expect no access to their driveways during this work.**

Please keep an eye out for the temporary water lines in your neighborhood. The contractor tries to secure the joints of the temporary water lines with tape or other means, but if you notice anyone tampering with the temporary water system, please notify me or the contractor as soon as possible. Children should not play on or near the temporary water system. Please contact me in the event a temporary water line becomes accidentally damaged.

Weather permitting, the contractor may begin storm sewer construction on the east end of Lake Avenue late in the week of June 13th or the following week of June 20th. This work will progress east to west along Lake Avenue. **Residents should expect no access to their driveways during this week.**

Construction is usually very interesting to children. However, there are many hazards on a construction site, and even the safest work area can be dangerous. The large equipment has a lot of blind spots and it is hard to see everything or everyone. Do not climb on or play near dirt piles, equipment, or work areas. Your cooperation in keeping children (and pets) away from the work area and equipment at all times is required and appreciated.

Survey stakes are being placed on the construction site. **Destruction or alteration of survey stakes results in slowing the work and additional cost to the city.**

If you're going to be hosting a graduation party at your house, please let me know the date of your party and I'll work with the contractor to accommodate access as best we can.
