ELYSIAN CITY COUNCIL BUDGET WORKSHOP MEETING JULY 27, 2020

The Elysian City Council held a budget workshop meeting on Monday, July 27, 2020 at City Hall at 6:00 pm.

Roll Call: Mayor Tom McBroom; Councilmembers Bobby Houlihan, Dennis Schnoor, Bryan Suemnick; City Administrator Lorri Kopischke. Absent: Councilmember Mary Opsahl.

Draft expense figures for the 2020 budget payable in 2021 were submitted for consideration. The budget includes a 2% COLA for all full-time employees. Some of the additional increases presented were insurance, generator for city hall, jet vac, and a new control panel with VFDS for the lift station at 301 East Hwy 60.

Draft revenue figures for the 2020 budget payable in 2021 were also submitted for consideration. Local Government Aid will see a small increase again this year.

Council discussed goose control at the beach, options for mosquito control and requested that a representative from Minnesota Pump Works attend a Council meeting to explain the benefits of the proposed new control panel at 301 East Hwy 60.

Council will review the documents presented and discussion will be held at a future budget workshop meeting.

Council then discussed the possibility of placing a question with regard to the conveyance of the DNR Wayside Rest on the November ballot. Council consensus was to not place a question on the November ballot and to postpone discussions on the issue until further communication is received from the MN DNR.

On motion by McBroom, seconded by Houlihan, all voting in favor, to adjourn the meeting at 7:40 pm.
