

**ELYSIAN CITY COUNCIL
EMERGENCY MEETING
MAY 17, 2022**

The Elysian City Council met in Emergency Session on Tuesday, May 17, 2022 at City Hall at 11:30 am.

Roll Call: Mayor Tom McBroom; Councilmembers Dennis Schnoor and Derek Westby; City Administrator Lorri Kopischke; Public Works Director Ron Greenwald; Utility Clerk Nicole Lamont. Absent: Councilmembers Bobby Houlihan and Bryan Suemnick.

Mayor McBroom explained that Cram Concrete has offered to build a sidewalk from the parking lot to the Veteran's Memorial at Sunset Park. Cram will donate all but \$3,500 of a \$25,000 project. The American Legion Post #311 has agreed to donate \$3,500. James Bros. Construction will donate the class 5 material for base. The only cost to the City of Elysian will be some shouldering along the sidewalk. Public Works has black dirt on hand for use.

The Elysian Park Board met last evening, May 16, 2022, and discussed the placement of the sidewalk. The Park Board approves the sidewalk.

Chris Cavett, SEH Engineering, was consulted on the size and location of the sidewalk. Cavett recommended that the sidewalk be (6) six feet wide and ADA compatible.

On motion by Schnoor, seconded by Westby, all voting in favor, to approve the installation of an ADA compatible 6 x 150 foot 4500 pound mix sidewalk with 2 bar runs with 4 inch of class 5 base and a 6 x 12 foot pad at the top. The sidewalk will be donated by Cram Concrete with the cost of materials in the amount of \$3,500 and the American Legion Post #311 will donate the \$3,500 cost. James Bros. Construction will donate the class 5 base material.

On motion by McBroom, seconded by Schnoor, all voting in favor, to adjourn the meeting at 11:40 am.
