The Elysian Economic Development Authority met in regular session on Thursday, May 5, 2022 at City Hall at 6:00 pm.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the US Flag.

Present were: President Mack Evans; Commissioners Bobby Houlihan and Steve Ritchison; Administrator Lorri Kopischke. Absent: Commissioners Jason Dillon and Derek Westby.

Revolving Fund Loan financial information was discussed. Loan #10 is paid in full. The owner of 2b and 2c has sold her building and is now renting space from a business in Elysian. She will be paying her monthly payment times ten each month or \$580. Loan #21 has not made a payment for two months. All other loans are current. The EDA restricted saving account balance is \$52,983.11 and unrestricted savings account balance is \$123,509.88 for a total savings account balance of \$176,492.99.

On motion by Houlihan, seconded by Evans, all voting in favor, to accept the financial report as presented.
