ELYSIAN CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL WORKSHOP MEETING NOVEMBER 28, 2022

The Elysian City Council held a special workshop meeting on Monday, November 28, 2022 at City Hall at 6:00 pm.

George Eilertson, Northland Securities, provided Preliminary Financing/Tax Impact Scenarios for the 2023 Street and Utility Improvement Project based on an assumption of a \$3 million cost and a 15-year term at 3.75%. Different scenarios were discussed, and Eilertson will provide an updated Tax Impact Scenario for discussion at the December 12, 2022 Council Meeting.

Councilmembers discussed 2023 Property Tax impact based on several examples of proposed tax statements; 2023 wage increases; increase for obtaining Class C Water Operator License; 2023 City contribution to health insurance premiums; proposals for security systems; auto and credit/debit utility payments options; and cell phone reimbursement.

Council suggested a wage study be completed for all job descriptions in 2023 and that the Public Works Director job description be updated to require a Class C Water Operator License.
