This letter is being sent to inform you of construction activity on the above-referenced project.

Over the last week the contractor was able to complete the installation of the new storm sewer and sanitary sewer on Maple Avenue, leaving only the intersection of 3rd Street and Maple Avenue and the remaining portion of 3rd Street for utility work. The turf establishment contractor has also been keeping an eye on recently seeded areas and watering as needed.

By the time you read this, the contractor will have installed drain tile and begun to install the new gravel road base on Maple Avenue. Their goal is to have this complete by the weekend. The plan for this coming week is to complete the installation of storm sewer up 3rd Street, then replace the water main in the intersection of 3rd Street and Maple Avenue. This will require a water shutdown in the area; advance notice will be given to affected residents. The only remaining work on 3rd Avenue will be a minor sanitary sewer repair before it is also subcut with the new gravel road base installed. Traffic control around this intersection may change at a moment's notice while this utility work takes place, however the contractor will be making every effort to maintain access to the surrounding areas.

Crews may also be out cutting holes in recently paved areas to install manhole covers and adjust water valve heights. The streets will not be closed at this time, but you will have to share the road with workers. Manhole covers that have just been raised are patched with pavement typically within a day.
