

**ELYSIAN CITY COUNCIL
WORKSHOP MEETING
MARCH 17, 2025**

The Elysian City Council held a workshop meeting on Monday, March 17, 2025 at City Hall at 6:00 pm.

Roll Call: Councilmembers Paul Hunter, Dennis Schnoor, and Derek Westby; City Administrator Lorri Kopischke. Absent: Mayor Tom McBroom, Sr. and Councilmember Bobby Houlihan.

The Council discussed meeting procedures and there was consensus to amend future council agendas to include a consent agenda and that the remainder of the meeting procedures remain unchanged.

Goose Control was discussed. Public Works will install the fencing once the ground is thawed. Staff will investigate geese deterrent options, contact other cities for their experiences, and consider soliciting bids from the Mannings and other contractors so as not to have this service done on an employee basis to reduce the City's liability.

The Council discussed providing benefits for part-time employees. No action will be taken at this time.

There was Council consensus for the public works employee who lives within City limits to drive the City truck home on the weekends that he is on-call. The Council would prefer that the truck not be taken home and left outside in inclement weather.

There will be no action taken on Willow Point Drive at this time.

The Council acknowledged the need for two new Christmas decorations for the streetlights and a roll of wire to repair existing decorations.
